COLOMBIA

Colombia is ranked as the third largest coffee producing country and the third largest exporter. The country produces only washed Arabica coffee.

Grown in high altitude lands, the combination of favorable climate, fertile soil and traditional farming practices contributes to the exceptional quality of the coffee, making it a favorite among coffee lovers worldwide.

Of the Arabica variety, Colombia La Meseta Supremo coffee is a high quality, large-grained coffee grown at altitudes above 1250 m. It is known for its bright acidity and full body.

Harvesting is carried out manually and meticulously. The ripe bean goes through several post-harvest stages. The washing process is divided into: hulling the bean, fermentation, washing and drying, so that the sensory characteristics of the coffee are enhanced.
