MARCALA, LA PAZ

Although Honduras is a small country compared to other coffee producing countries, its soil and climate are ideal for harvesting. This has made the country stand out in the coffee scene. Marcala is renowned for its production of high-quality organic coffee with a distinct sensory profile.

Strictly High Grown (SHG) indicates that the coffee was grown above 1200m. At higher altitudes, the bean develops more slowly, resulting in a bean that is denser in nutrients and therefore has a more intense flavor.

Harvesting is done manually, allowing only the ripest cherries to be selected. Processing is done using the washed method, further enhancing the taste of the coffee.
