Fazenda Rodomunho is a family business located near the famous Parnaíba River in Minas Gerais, combining passion and innovation. Its origins date back to family immigration: Thiago Corsi's mother came from Portugal to Rio de Janeiro, while his father immigrated from Italy to the south of Minas Gerais. After meeting in Paraná, the family settled in the Cerrado Mineiro region in 1985, marking the beginning of the farm's history. Now the 4th generation of producers, it preserves its traditions and values family management.



Producer Thiago Corsi relies on the collaboration of his brothers, Renato and Rodrigo, and his mother Elzi, who is responsible for finances, as well as cousins and brothers-in-law. The close and humanized relationship between Thiago and his employees is directly reflected in the excellence of quality of their coffees

The farm occupies 450 hectares and, since 2019, has been dedicated to the cultivation of specialty coffees.

Due to the challenges in agriculture, such as the impacts caused by climate, pests and diseases, regenerative agriculture is a solution to mitigate these effects, ensuring sustainable practices and reinforcing the farm's commitment to responsible and high-quality production.
